**About Carl Patterson;** Carl Patterson built many Moth Boats and contributed to the Yacht Club of Sea Isle City, NJ becoming a successful Moth Boat fleet. He started building “Connecticut” Moths in the mid 50’s, moved on to building “Cates” Moths into the early 60’s, then in 1964 he built the first “Shelley” Moth in the U.S., boat # 2690. His son Bob sailed #2690 to win the Junior International Championship in 1965. Carl built many more Shelleys and was the authorized importer for William McCutcheon, John Shelley’s builder on the Isle of Wight, U.K.
