- 1. **Organizing Authority:** The organizing authority is the Classic Moth Boat Association (CMBA) and River City Community Sailing.
- 2. **Venue:** The venue is John and Sarah Pugh's house, 900 Riverside Avenue, on the Pasquotank River and Coast Guard Park in Elizabeth City, NC.
- 3. **Boat Divisions:** Three divisions of Moth Boats will be racing: Vintage, Generation I Classic and Generation II Classic.
- 4. Also this year Open Bics, Toppen Unos, Argos, and Sunfish will be raced on Saturday.
- 5. **Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as changed by the Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.

- 10. **Measurement:** All new Mothboats and sails must be measured prior to racing. A CMBA Measurer will be on site after 12pm on Friday to measure new boats and sails.
